


## What is: Progress and Transparency

Progress and transparency refers to the methods used to measure progress over time after an Action Plan is developed or updated, including outcome data.

# Quick Tip! It is only necessary to include methodology details for this component in your Action Plan; you do not need to execute all activities before finishing your plan.

### Identify evaluation metrics based on your jurisdiction and Action Plan goals.

Near-miss incidents


Speeding violations

Public perception of safety




### 1 Develop

### Determine how you will track and share your progress publicly.


- Consider:
