

SS4A Traffic Crash Data Form

Background: Section 24112 of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (Public Law 117-58) requires that the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) periodically share best practices and lessons learned from the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program. Recipients of Implementation Grants and Planning and Demonstration Grants with activities that result in changes to the built environment must submit traffic crash data before and after these activities take place. These reports must be submitted in accordance with the performance measures listed in Attachment A of the grant agreement. The information you provide will help the USDOT evaluate program benefits and outcomes and meet the reporting requirements of Section 24112.

Instructions

Report crash information for each project location where projects were or will be implemented and/or each location where a demonstration activity was or will be conducted. If safety countermeasures were installed systemically (over a large geographic area), you may provide area-wide information. Use the most recent available data covering a 12-month period. If you are reporting more than ten separate locations, submit a second form.

Please note: **when submitting your information using the Microsoft Form(s), your submission must be completed in one sitting.** It is not possible to save your responses partway through and return to complete the form later. This template can be used to research your answers so that you can copy and paste them into the online form more easily.
